



VERIFICATION OF ADDRESS

Persons meeting the residency requirements who would like a library card will need to show valid picture ID and verification of their current address.

Acceptable documents for verification of current address include:

- Nevada Driver License or ID with current address;
- Imprinted checks from a Nevada bank;
- A property tax record, utility bill, mortgage document or Deed, current rental receipt, a lease or rental agreement;
- Escrow papers with current address;
- Credit card statement, medical bill, telephone bill, or other statement or request for payment mailed to the residence address dated within the previous 60 days;
- Medicaid card (current month only);
- Nevada vehicle registration and/or Proof of Nevada vehicle insurance;
- School enrollment records for the current semester;
- Student I.D. for current semester or year;
- Notarized statement from a property owner that you are residing with them or on their property without a rental or lease agreement;
- Tribal, government or educational institution issued picture ID with a current date and a residential address.
- Washoe County Property Tax Statement
- Timeshare proof-of-ownership papers

CHILDREN

Parents or guardians of minor children may obtain library cards for their children by providing acceptable identification.

NON-RESIDENTS

Non-residents may apply for an annual library card and pay an annual fee for borrowing privileges. Acceptable I.D. is still required.

CONDITIONAL CARDS

Documentation required for the issuance of a conditional card is at the discretion of the manager or their designee.
