



The U.S. Constitution requires a count every 10 years of every person living in the United States. Census results determine how the federal government allocates more than \$800 billion each year for services that communities rely on.

Census data also determines representation in Congress and the Electoral College, as well as in state and local governments.

Beginning March 12, 2020, the Census Bureau will mail every household in the United States an invitation to respond to the census, including a new option to respond online. Remember, you can visit any Washoe County Library to use computers to complete the Census. Library staff will be on the front lines to help you get started.




