Bringing books and other learning materials to far-flung corners of our communities has been part of Washoe County Library's mission since the beginning.

This November, local voters will have a chance to help decide the next chapter of library history with a possible renewal of the Library Expansion Fund. This dedicated funding source, initially approved by Washoe County voters in 1994 for a period of 30 years, allowed us to build and operate the Incline Village, Northwest Reno, Spanish Springs, and South Valleys Libraries. Other branches have benefitted as well, with the expansion of services, hours, and collections. You can learn more about this fund and its potential renewal at washoelibrary.org/expansionfund.

Speaking of improvements, the American Rescue Plan Act funded our most recent renovations—repairing and replacing flooring, furniture, and other amenities at our South Valleys and Spanish Springs libraries. These are two of our most popular locations, and with these recent renovations they are now better than ever. If you haven't visited either branch recently—or ever—now is the time.

Of course, there are exciting things happening at all our branches! In the pages of the Explorer, you will discover the perfect events for you and your family. 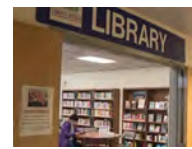

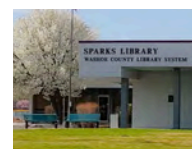

Welcome back, bookmobile services! North Valleys Library Branch Manager Jonnica

The Washoe County Library System has served local residents since 1904 when the first Carnegie Free Public Library opened in downtown Reno. Soon thereafter, our dedicated staff extended library service in creative ways, such as launching a recurring radio program in the 1930s and '40s; offering library services directly to patients in the local Washoe General and Saint Mary's hospitals; and using their personal vehicles to drive hundreds of miles to deliver reading materials to ranching families in the northern border area of Washoe County known as Vya, Nevada.

In 1947, Extension Librarian Darrel Cain and a colleague drove to Treasure Island, California, to pick up their newly purchased surplus Army ambulance, which was retrofitted to hold books. Mr. Cain delivered books to the eight book stations, many schools, and community agencies in the area. The bookmobile featured robust tires fit for Army service, which were needed for driving hundreds of miles on dirt roads to places like Vya, Gerlach, and Empire.

Washoe County Library maintained regular bookmobile services throughout the county and nearby rural areas, such as Lyon, Storey, and Douglas counties. By the 1980s, the system had multiple bookmobiles—some delivering physical materials, and others specializing in providing mobile story times and other activities. In 2001, the 35-foot-long Mobile Library bookmobile was launched. The large vehicle offered full library service to residents and continued to make regular stops at various locations until its retirement in 2010 following the Great Recession.

In 2021, Washoe County residents participated in community forums to help guide the creation of the library's 2022-2025 Strategic Plan. After these discussions, we could not ignore the impassioned requests from residents to revive bookmobile services in Washoe County.

Because of the hard work of library staff and the financial support from a grant by the Institute of Museum and Library Services, administered by the Nevada State Library and Archives, we are excited to announce this quarter's Explorer cover star, the new Library on the Go bookmobile!
