Washoe County Library System has had a busy 2023. As the winter Explorer goes to press, we have just closed the Downtown Reno Library for a much-needed elevator replacement. Work on that project will be completed in early 2024. We are also eagerly anticipating our new bookmobile, "Library on the Go/Biblioteca Móvil," which will debut in December 2023. The bookmobile will join our recently expanded Library to Go kiosks and our homebound delivery service to expand access to the library's collection to even more Washoe County residents.

These exciting changes come on the heels of other accessibility projects: new family restrooms at the Downtown Reno Library and an ADA-accessible external entrance and lift at the Sierra View Library. Thanks to our efforts with Washoe County to expand broadband internet access in rural areas, we were also able to bring WiFi and Chromebook access to the Pyramid Lake and Hungry Valley Libraries, with WiFi available additionally in Wadsworth and Sutcliffe.

2023 saw a steep rise in book challenges and other attempts by some members of the community to restrict or prevent access to certain materials. During Banned Books Week in October, we highlighted titles that had been hidden, damaged, checked out indefinitely, or otherwise prevented from reaching new readers. Our "Censored by your neighbors" display at the Spanish Springs Library, along with other innovative Banned Books Week displays at other branches, did a great job of raising community awareness and creating a wider discussion about censorship and access here in Washoe County.

We're kicking off 2024 with great events and services you can discover on the following pages. We hope you find something that's just right for you and your family. Visit us in person to join in the fun, browse for books, and connect with your favorite librarians. Or, visit us online to see what's new, place and manage holds, or access ebooks, audiobooks, and digital magazines with the Libby app. We can't wait to see you at the library!
