There's high demand, and the technology improvements will provide the immediate ability to stream meetings and events from these rooms. #### Give Thanks, Give Food this December

Washoe County Library System is partnering with the Food Bank of Northern Nevada to combat hunger in our community. During November and December, patrons are invited to donate cans and boxes of nonperishable food to most Washoe County Library locations. (The Incline Village and Sparks libraries are not accepting donations.) Food must be in store-sealed cans, boxes, or plastic containers before its expiration date. Glass containers, perishable food, or opened containers cannot be accepted.







# Elevator improvements and new kiosks arrive at the Downtown Reno Library

The elevator at the Downtown Reno Library is operational and ADA-compliant after a months-long renovation period. Library staff are thrilled that the 1960s-era elevator has been upgraded to meet 2024 standards.

The Downtown Reno, North Valleys, Incline Village, and Sparks libraries now offer on-site access to legal kiosks supported by Nevada Legal Services. These kiosks can be used to attend virtual legal appointments and court hearings. They also provide free printing and scanning. Access to the kiosks is available on a first come, first served basis.

Reno Housing Authority partnered with Washoe County Library System to bring a new service kiosk to the Downtown Reno Library. Through the user-friendly kiosk, community members can find information about Housing Authority programs, find, complete, print, and upload documents, apply to open waiting lists, pay rent online, and more. Access to the kiosk is available Sunday through Friday, from 10 am to 5 pm.

#### The South Valleys Library debuts facility upgrades

Washoe County recently designated American Rescue Plan Act funds toward improvements at the Spanish Springs and South Valleys libraries. In addition to an updated Teens Only space at the Spanish Springs branch, improvements to interior and exterior spaces have been completed at the South Valleys Library. Renovated areas include the Teen Zone, updated periodicals area, south patio sunshade, and the Mt. Rose Room. # Meet a Librarian! Maya

#### What Spanish language events do you have at the Sparks Library?

We have Bilingual Story Time, a family story time for kids of all ages. We have Book a Librarian in Spanish, Reserva un bibliotecario, which reserves 50 minutes for us to assist a person one-on-one with questions ranging from "How do I create an email address?" to "How do I apply for unemployment?" We have Spanish language computer classes. First, we start with basic computer skills. Then it goes into how to use the internet safely. From there, it goes into how to use email. And we're starting a Microsoft Word class. I joined the library in 2019 and offered up the idea of Spanish programming, and the Sparks Library has been really welcoming to the idea.

#### Tell us more about bilingual story time.

Growing up in my house, I would speak Spanish to my parents. I would speak English with my siblings. The language mixture is just something I'm used to. When I was in school, I didn't have much Spanish interaction, and I started losing some of my Spanish. I just want kids — and parents — to know that it's OK to use Spanish. I want kids to know that Spanish is part of life. I want them to know that hearing Spanish outside the home is a normal thing.

#### Tell us more about the Book a Librarian services.

I mention to the students for my Spanish computer courses that if they have more advanced questions, then I can do Book a Librarian with them. I've had a few students who were interested in Excel, but we didn't offer that program, so they would sit with me during Book a Librarian. Some had questions about how they could be more involved in the community, so I showed them how to look up volunteer communities online. I've shown them how to set up social media accounts. It's a little bit of everything.

#### What's the last great book you read?

For a children's book, it's *Eleven Words* for Love: A Journey Through Arabic Expressions of Love by Randa Abdel-Fattah and Maxine Beneba Clarke. Although Spanish is the second-most spoken language, after English, in Washoe County, I also want to introduce my story time participants to other languages. I take a month beforehand to learn the words and do my best to pronounce them. I use the library's Mango Languages for pronunciation. This is the latest book I've done. It went well, and I plan to keep using it periodically just to show our community that there are more than two languages in Washoe County.

#### What's a library resource you wish more people knew about?

The technology classes. Because as technology keeps advancing, if someone doesn't know the basics, they keep getting left further and further behind. So, whether it's the English computer classes, the iPhone and Android classes offered at the Sparks Library and the North Valleys Library, I want people to know that technology help is available in the library. You don't have to pay for it outside. You can learn the basics here and then expand from there.

#### ¿Qué eventos en español tienen en la Biblioteca de Sparks?

Tenemos La hora del cuento bilingüe (Bilingual Story Time). Esta es una hora de cuento en familia dedicada a los niños de todas las edades. Tenemos lo que se conoce como Reserva un bibliotecario en español, lo cual permite reservar por 50 minutos la ayuda a una persona individualmente con preguntas que van desde "¿Cómo puedo establecer una dirección de correo electrónico?" hasta "¿Cómo puedo solicitar el desempleo?" Tenemos clases de computación en español. Primero, comenzamos con las habilidades informáticas básicas. Luego, pasamos a aprender cómo se puede usar el Internet de manera segura. A partir de ahí, pasamos a cómo usar el correo electrónico. Y también estamos iniciando una clase de Microsoft Word. Me uní a la biblioteca en el año 2019 y ofrecí la idea de la programación en español, y la Biblioteca de Sparks fue muy muy receptiva a esa idea.

#### Cuéntanos más sobre La hora del cuento bilingüe.

Cuando era niña, hablaba en español con mis padres y en inglés con mis hermanos. Estoy acostumbrada a la mezcla de ambos idiomas. Cuando iba a la escuela, no tenía mucha interacción con el español y empecé a perder algo de mi español. Solo deseo que los niños — y los padres — sepan que está muy bien hacer uso del idioma español. Quiero que los niños sepan que el español es parte de la vida. Quiero que sepan que escuchar español fuera de la casa es algo muy normal.

#### Cuéntanos más sobre los servicios de Reserva un bibliotecario (Book a Librarian).

Les digo a los estudiantes de mis clases de informática en español que si tienen preguntas más avanzadas, pueden hacerlo a través de Book a Librarian con estas personas. He tenido algunos estudiantes que estaban interesados en aprender Excel, pero no ofrecíamos ese programa, así que se sentaban conmigo durante Book a Librarian. Algunos tenían preguntas acerca de cómo podrían participar más en la comunidad, así que les mostré cómo buscar comunidades de voluntarios en línea. Les mostré cómo configurar sus cuentas en las redes sociales. Es un poco de todo.

#### ¿Cuál es el último gran libro que leíste?

Es un libro de niños y se llama *Once palabras para el amor: Un viaje a través de las expresiones arabes de amor* de Randa Abdel-Fattah y Maxine Beneba Clarke. Aunque el español es el segundo idioma más hablado, después del idioma inglés, en el Condado de Washoe, también quiero presentarles a los participantes otros idiomas durante de mi hora del cuento. Me tomo un mes de anticipación para aprender las palabras y hago todo lo posible por pronunciarlas. Uso la aplicación Mango Languages de la biblioteca de manera de poder descubrir cómo pronunciar todo. Este es el último libro que he leído. Salió bien y planeo seguir usándolo periódicamente de modo de mostrarle a nuestra comunidad que hay más de dos idiomas en el Condado de Washoe.

#### ¿Qué recurso con el cual cuenta la biblioteca desearías que más personas

Las clases de tecnología. Porque a medida que la tecnología sigue avanzando, si alguien no conoce los conceptos básicos, se va quedando cada vez más atrás. Por eso, ya sean las clases de informática en inglés, las clases de iPhone y Android que se ofrecen en la Biblioteca de Sparks y la Biblioteca de North Valleys, quiero que la gente sepa que hay ayuda tecnológica disponible en la biblioteca. No es necesario que uno lo tenga que pagar afuera. Una persona puede aprender los conceptos básicos aquí mismo y luego ampliarlos a partir de allí




