




Spanish Springs Library 20th Anniversary Party

Meet a Librarian! Pam Larsen

The Library on the Go bookmobile launched one year ago. What's your role on the bookmobile?

I'm the lead librarian on the bookmobile. It operates like one of our partnership branches, and the majority of the staff covering it are from the North Valleys Library. We want patrons to have a good experience with the bookmobile, so we want them to go home with library materials. We want patrons to think, "Oh, the county offers this as well as physical branches!" The bookmobile offers new publications, and we've curated some collections for it, like the kids' collection. Originally, people didn't think we would really have a lot of kids on there, but we have a lot of kids, and the kids absolutely love it. They think it's the coolest thing ever.

What's a memorable interaction you've had with a bookmobile visitor?

We've had a lot of super positive interactions. The other day, we had a kid who was about 8 come on the bookmobile. He was very excited, but he only wanted to get two books because he wanted other people to check things out, which I thought was adorable. We were at Virginia Lake Park. And I said, "Oh, are you going to go walk with your dad?" Because his dad was there. But he said, "No, we're not going to go walk. I just saw that you lend books, and that you're part of the library system, and I love books! And I love the library!" And I said, "That's amazing. Thank you for coming on and only taking two books." I love that they come on, and they're just jazzed. I love it when adults come on and are jazzed too. They'll come on and say, "Oh, this is brand new!" Yes, this is a brand new service with brand new books. They recognize that they're getting the best of everything.

Tell us about the North Valleys Library.

North Valleys is one of the smaller branches. We have a small staff, and a small space because we're in a rented facility. However, for this community, we serve as a key place for them to come and do things. Even during the pandemic, we were still busy. We still had people coming in to pick up their holds. The patrons are really good about putting things on hold. We have a very active book club.

We have a number of computers. We have the legal kiosk, which is really cool. We have a core team that does a lot of programs. We have Crafternoon and STEAM programs. We also offer three Story Times and Paws 2 Read, but we still have the ability to help everybody on the floor with all their needs. It's a small branch that feels really intimate.

Tell us about your background.

I've been with the system for almost 20 years now. I started at the Sparks Library. I decided to go back to school when I got promoted and was at Sierra View. I went back and finished my four-year degree because I left school when I had kids, and then I was out of school for a hot second, maybe a year, and then I was right back in going for a master's program. I didn't really think that I would ever be a librarian because I'm dyslexic, so as a child I didn't read at all ever. It was the worst thing in the world when people would give me books for Christmas or my birthday. It was like, "Great! Another thing I can't actually use." So I never really read until I got married. My ex-husband was an avid reader, so I ended up reading quite a lot. I tell kids all the time, "I didn't read as a kid. It doesn't mean you can't succeed at something. You just have to practice and learn how to do it."

What was the last great book you read?

The Barn: The Secret History of a Murder in Mississippi by Wright Thompson. It's a history of America. It's a history of a place — the Mississippi Delta, Half my family is from there. My mom was born and raised in New Orleans. The barn was where Emmett Till was murdered. It's the history of a place and how people left and how people came back. and if certain things hadn't happened. Emmett Till wouldn't have even been there. It's really interesting because I haven't read a lot about the Mississippi Delta that goes into this much depth with this much history.

> And it goes all the way back — back to blues music -Robert Johnson, Charley Patton, and Muddy Waters. They all fled to Chicago. Emmett Till was born and raised in Chicago. He went with his cousin and his best friend to visit a distant relative in the South. And that's the only reason he was there. It's just sad. And it touches on all kinds of things. It's a very interesting book. It's a hard read.

What's a library resource you wish more people knew about?

I would say LinkedIn Learning because a lot of people spend a lot of time trying to learn things on their own, and LinkedIn Learning will have a training on it. You could just go in there and learn at your own pace, and for most people, it would be much easier than trying to read a book and following along. I've taught myself programs that way, and it's not easy. LinkedIn Learning will teach you step by step how to do something. And it's something that everyone has access to if you have a library card.


